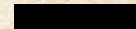

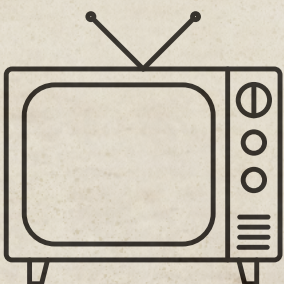

## This Week on Telly - Round 3

(Answer: 9) The very first letters of Thom's Favourite Day at fourteen.

- There is one showing of "For the love of Thursdays" hosted by Thom (Wednesday, Channel 3, 4pm).
- "At fourteen" refers to 14:00.
- Thursday at 14:00 has four programmes starting - the first letters of each programme are: "N", "I", "N", "E".
